The HOA annual meeting is scheduled to take place on Thursday, February 20, 2020 at 7:00 PM at the Northside Church of the Nazarene, 6781 Bayside Road, North Fort Myers, Fl. Longleaf Drive - Single Family Homes

This past January 25th the Single Family Homeowners participated in a volunteer day to start the clean up of the Longleaf Drive Entrance. Due to the drifting debris from the shopping center and security concerns for adjacent homeowners, a large mass of saw palmettos was removed adjacent to the Bayshore Shopping Plaza along with multiple layers of leaves and trash. Also removed was the invasive plantings of Asparagus Fern and Mexican Petunias from the North Planting Bed. Improvements are ongoing as it is in the works to eventually install a permanent fence between this area and the shopping center. After the many stumps have been ground down and addressed, plants will be slowly added to finish the bed improvements. Thoughtful neighbors have already began to donated the much needed flora and are appreciated for their kindness. Signs have been erected reminding all local residents to Please Stay Off The Grass as using these areas as a shortcut is a nuisance and security threat for the residents with appointed jurisdiction over these parcels. If you are walking for exercise please stay on the pavement and appreciate the extra steps you earned.

I want to personally extend my upmost gratitude for all those who participated in and continue to help with this much needed update, and also to those who continue to support the improvements necessary for our property investments to grow.


