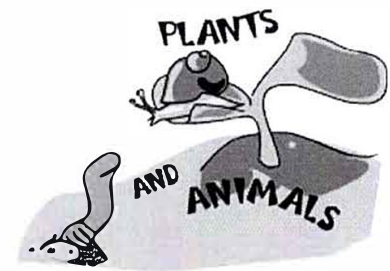
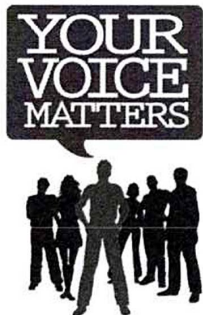

BINGO

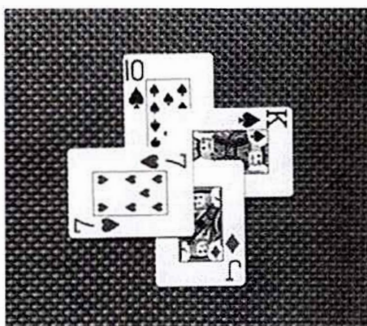
BINGO

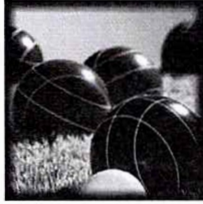

by three teams with records of 5 and 2, and an additional 7 teams have records of 4 and 3.

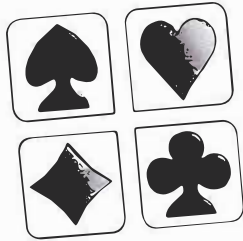
With 3

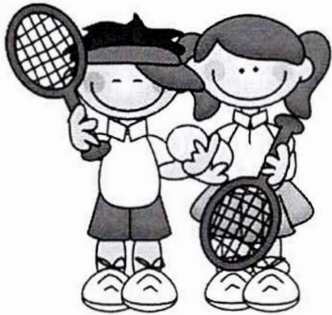
Pickle Ball News

and committee members Christina Bucek and Maura Redmond

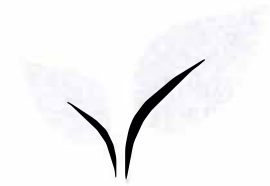
