Lip Smacking Good! Once again the Coppola Claret proves to be a winner! The 2016 Coppola Black Label Claret is another superb vintage from a winery that knows how to produce a quality red blend in the Bordeaux style, without breaking the bank.

The wine has a big nose, big robust flavors, and a finish which begs for another sip! The flavors of juicy black cherry and jammy blackberry flow through a complex array of cocoa, vanilla, and a touch of toasty oak. The alcohol content is 13.5%, and Norm's score is 90.

This is definitely a wine for steak, but don't stop there, for it will also pair wel with the full spectrum of grilled meats, and would make a great companion for a dish like prime rib. Bring on the beef!

Knowing Your AB(Y)Cs

When buying a pre-owned vessel no matter what size, the best investment a buyer can make is to have the vessel surveyed, Pier One Yacht Sales owners Len Garofoli and Tony Mondello agree.

Having a vessel surveyed along with a mechanical inspection may point out issues that are not noticed during the initial review of the boat.

Mondello said that as you go through your survey report you may find some items noted as saying "does not meet ABYC standard" or "does not meet current ABYC standards".

ABYC stands for American Boat and Yacht Council. The ABYC publishes "standards and technical information reports for small craft" and these "standards" are accepted by many boat manufacturers, surveyors, and repair technicians as industry standards, just as exist in many other manufacturing industries. They were previously referred to as "ABYC standards and recommended practices."

These standards are constantly being reviewed updated by the ABYC technical committees, ar new publication of the "standards" is issued annu-They are continuously researched, developed revised by over 400 volunteer marine professio on 16 project technical committees (PTCs) from fields of the industry including the U.S. Coast Gu (USCG), trade organizations and private enti-ABYC collaborates with safety organizat worldwide such as Transport Canada and International organization for the Standardiza (ISO). As a result of strong industry and governn support, ABYC has evolved into the prer standards developer in the recreational boa industry, and the viable alternative to manda government regulations of the marine industry.

Depending on the age of the vessel you buying, standards that existed at the time the ve was manufactured may have changed. An item your survey noted as "not meeting ABYC standa does not mean that is broken or defective. It means that the standards for the item may h changed since the vessel was built. An example changing standards could be: a vessel built in '90s may have had 3" engine room blowers ar vessel built now may have 4" engine room blow This is not saying that the 3" blowers are not wor or defective, just the standards have chang Another example may be that the vessels built in early 2000s had a certain size bilge pump, or a pu that was rated at certain gallons per hour. In tod vessel, the rating may be for more gallons per h Again, not saying that the bilge pump is not wor or defective, just the standards have changed. The is no requirement for a vessel to be modified to r a current standard, and in many cases it would impractical to do so.

If an item on this vessel is broken or not world properly, it will be noted accordingly.

Fishing enthusiasts across Southwest Florida who haven't experienced tarpon fishing, or are looking to gain further insight on one of the area's most sought-after fish can do so via a club that's been in Cape Coral for nearly half a century. The Cape Coral Tarpon Hunters Club, established in 1971, is the premiere Tarpon fishing group in the world. The group's history includes more than 10,000 catches and provides a strong foundation to introduce new members — men and women alike — to the world of Tarpon fishing.

"We emphasize ethical catch and release," said Cape Coral Tarpon Hunters President, David Beam. "We teach and practice humane tactics so that the fish can survive after enduring the fight."

Members can strive to learn about strategical tactics in catching a "silver king," such as rod/reel selection, terminal tackle rigging, bait prep and onwater etiquette. The Tarpon Hunters fish out of the Gulf of Mexico, Pine-Island Sound and the Caloosahatchee River. The tarpon season runs from March 1 until the end of September, as the group holds monthly tarpon hunts, where members can get out on the water for a day of camaraderie and angling — no matter the skill level.

"It's the spirit of friendly competition that makes this group special," said Beam. "I used to fish in other clubs and tournaments where people would keep any tips or information close to the vest, our club is the opposite. Everyone helps one another learn how to fish for tarpon, provide insight and share the wealth so everyone can join in on the fun." Beam himself got involved during a pre-season membership meeting a few years back, and said the club has be "beyond my expectations." Other than just the lc of fishing, those involved create personal bonds tl exceed time on the water. "It's just a great group people," he said.

Being active in the community is also a goal of t club, holding a Special Pops Outing each year youth. The Tarpon Hunters also hold month meeting throughout the season featuring speakers a variety of angling and sport fishing topics. T group has had 11 Grand Master Tarpon Anglers in history, meaning having caught and released 200 more tarpon. One member, Jerry Geyer, has cauge 926 tarpon heading into the 2019 season, as hoping to hit the 1,000 plateau. There are four oth active members who have notched at least 300 more catch-and-releases. An annual awards banquis held each year to celebrate the season that was a to recognize the group's top anglers.






